



L'Oréal-UNESCO For Women in Science Fellowships 2014 Application Guidelines

1. Fellowships would be awarded to three chosen candidates. The amount of RM 30,000 each.
2. Fellowships will be awarded to candidates pursuing their Doctoral studies or PhD holders who are at the early stage of their career.
3. Fellowships will be awarded in the field of 'Life' sciences.
4. Candidates must be Malaysian below 40 years of age. Thus, applicants born before 1st January 1974 will not be considered under this program
5. Candidates should demonstrate academic excellence and the research project must be feasible with a high potential in contributing advances to research in Malaysia.
6. Applications must be submitted with an application form which can be found at L'Oréal Malaysia website www.loreal.com.my to be addressed to the Jury President for submission.
7. The following must be included in the application: -
 - Application form
 - Curriculum vitae, mentioning the applicants most important scientific publications
 - Certified copies of degrees or diplomas
 - Detailed description, one or two pages of the research project for the forthcoming year
 - Description must include:
 - a) *Title of the project*
 - b) *Objective of the research program*
 - c) *Background*
 - d) *Rationale*
 - e) *Methodology*
 - f) *Expected output*
 - g) *Scientific supervisor's recommendation or recommendation of the head of the scientific institution where the project will be realized*
 - h) *List of scientific publications*
8. Each application form shall be signed by the Dean/ Head of the unit in which the candidate will realize the research work.
9. Application must be submitted by 30th May 2014 to the Malaysian National Commission for UNESCO with the required documentation at the following address:

10. Applications that are incomplete or have been submitted after the due date shall not be considered.
11. The selection takes into consideration the eligibility criteria, application requirements/documents and objectives and policies of FWIS.
12. The selections are highly competitive and will be based on country standards and jury recommendations. Selection by jury panel is FINAL and will not be contested.
13. Candidates must provide 2 periodic reports of the project within one year of receiving the grant. At the end of the grant period, a complete financial disbursement report covering the entire grant period and a final progress report must be submitted to L'Oréal Malaysia.
